District Attorney Nola Tedesco Foulston announces the **Meth Kids Initiative**, a task force that her office initiated several years ago to work with children located in meth labs, will hold a one-day training on March 1, 2005 and a duplicate training on March 2, 2005 for direct care providers. This training will be held at the Sedgwick County Forensic Science Center at 1109 N. Minneapolis. The training will begin with registration from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and end with a question and answer session from 4:15 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Discussion will include meth effects on users, meth effects on kids, interviewing techniques, etc.

Several agencies on the Task Force will have personnel available or involved. These include, but are not limited to, KBI, DEA, Wichita Police Dept., Sedgwick County Sheriff's Dept., Wesley Medical Center, Forensic Science Center, and others.

This training is not open to the general public but media are invited to participate in portions of the training including the question and answer session.
