District Attorney Nola Tedesco Foulston announces today the indictment of Kellogg Gift Shop, Inc. d/b/a Priscilla's and its owner, Robert Floyd, each on one count of Promoting Obscenity, a Class A misdemeanor. The indictments allege that on September 9, 2005, the defendants possessed an obscene DVD with the intent to lend, sell or deliver it. The indictments were issued by a grand jury that was summoned in response to a petition calling for the investigation of seven adult entertainment establishments in Wichita: Adult Superstore, 5858 S. Broadway; After Dark Video, 7805 W. Kellogg; Camelot Cinema, 1515 S. Oliver; Priscilla's, 6143 W. Kellogg; X-Citement Video Store, 1306 E. Harry; X-Citement Video Store, 220 E. 21st St.; and Zigfields, 4200 W. Kellogg.

The grand jury was impaneled on September 19, 2005 and was discharged after completing its investigation on October 26, 2005. No additional indictments were handed down.

Arraignments were today and a trial date has been set for December 13, 2005 at 9:00 a.m.
