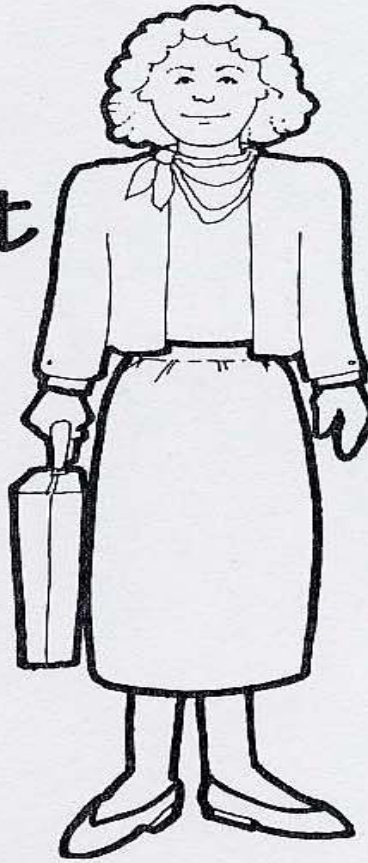
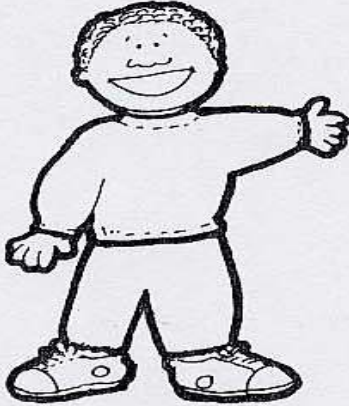


What does the District Attorney do?
