MRC volunteer opportunities are intended for the following individuals:

- Non medical background who have desire to assist in the areas of outreach events, administrative tasks, and public assistance
- Individuals with healthcare experience or emergency training skills (not licensed)
- Volunteers with current medical or healthcare licensure and/or certifications

All MRC volunteers bring worthy and needed skills to our community. There are no requirements for participation other than training and refresher training. We anticipate some volunteers will serve only during times of great need, and others will participate 3 or more times a year in public health & community outreach efforts.
