On the recommendation of Joe Thomas, on behalf of Risk Management, Linda Kizzire moved to accept the insurance premium renewals as listed for an estimated total cost of \$678,482.00. Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

In general, the insurance market has not been profitable for the last year or so which has caused the market to increase rates and premiums. The county insurance agent has done an excellent job in negotiating a renewal that holds the line on premiums.

Risk Management recommends continuation of property insurance for the county with Alliant and its PEPIP (Public Entity Property Insurance Program). This program is not licensed in the State of Kansas so a non-admitted fee must be paid. The fee is included in the premiums shown. The renewal for all other insurance coverage is recommended with the incumbent insurance companies as shown in the table. The Professional Liability carrier for the doctors has declared a dividend that is payable to the doctors based on their experience and years insured.

The total amount of this dividend is \$4,000.00, which will return to the County. Excess Workers' Compensation changes: 1.5% decrease in estimated annual payroll, 7.96% increase in rate, and an overall premium increase 6.97%.
