On the recommendation of Emily Dudley, on behalf of Fleet Management, David Spears moved **to accept the low bid meeting specifications from Doonan Truck, Option 4, for \$975,474.54.** Don Brace seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Note: The low bid from Kansas Truck Center did not meet specifications because they bid an alternate mounting position for the fuel tank and tool box and their units had galvanized steel cabs rather than the aluminum as specified in the document. Their bid also included a delivery date of 210-220 days, which is an important factor to the department due to the fact that the existing trucks are in a poor condition and require a significant amount of additional maintenance and labor costs. The bid from Roberts Truck Center did not meet specifications because an alternate engine and transmission combination which included an automatic transmission that would require a larger engine (effecting fuel efficiency and also possibly requiring this truck to be considered a class 8 truck, which leads to additional costs for parts and maintenance). The bid from Doonan, Option 2b did not meet specifications because it did not include an automatic lube system and they bid an alternate type of sand spreader controller than was specified in the document; and the bid from Doonan, Option 3, did not meet specifications because it did not include the automatic lube system.
