On the recommendation of Dallas Shaffer, on behalf of Sedgwick County Regional Forensic Science Center, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the quote from Agilent Technologies in the amount of \$65,873.95.** David Spears seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Note: Agilent Technologies is the provider of support services on instrumentation and software for the Forensic Science Center. The Service Agreement covers 12 different instruments, i.e., autosampler units, gas chromatographs and mass spectrometers, along with 45 various equipment and accessory components that support the instruments; and provides ongoing technical support for hardware and software; annual preventive maintenance, calibration, and certification of equipment.

The Agilent instruments used in our laboratories are a fundamental tool for identification and quantization (determining how much of a substance) of drugs found in forensic specimens. This includes all postmortem (autopsy) cases, driving under the influence and sexual assault cases, as well as analysis of illicit drugs. Agilent service contracts are necessary to support our equipment hardware and software needs and are a crucial component of the high quality and timeliness of our work. Last year's cost was \$63,927.60 based on last years inventory of 34 components. As new equipment comes off of warranty, the number of components change year to year.
