The following questions were received in response to this Request for Proposal. Questions are italicized and answers are bolded.

You must acknowledge receipt of this addendum on your response form.

1. *In the RFP, page 6, Section 2. c) Management Plan asks for a timeline. Since our request is for a continuation grant and staff are already in place, could you please explain what information is needed here?* **The timeline should be specific to your program. If it is an existing program there would be no time allocation for start up but the timeline should still demonstrate the general timeframe for program services.**
2. *In the RFP, page 6, Section 2. c) Management Plan asks for staffing patterns. Do you want only staff funded by Sedgwick County or all staff providing youth treatment services at our agency?* **Staffing patterns should illustrate how the proposed program is or will be staffed. If staff funded from sources other than the proposed grant will be providing services for the grant program they should be listed in the staffing pattern. To avoid confusion please mention which staff are proposed to be funded through the requested grant and which are funded from other sources.**
3. *Are local school districts eligible to apply for grant funds?* **Yes**
4. *Approximately how many awards will be made?* **The number of awards will depend on what proposals are funded. Currently there are nine programs funded.**
5. *Is there a dollar limit for proposals?* **There are no dollar limits for a proposal. The total available is \$850,000.**
6. *It looks like the award dates have changed to more of a school year as opposed to calendar year, so July 1 thru June 30th, is that correct?* **Yes the funds are allocated on a July to June fiscal year.**
7. *Our program is approved by CDC as they are the ones who developed it, but it is not on the list of evidence-based programs on the Blueprints website. We would like to write for some funding to support what we are doing in the community. Can we still be considered for these funds without the Blueprints rating?* **Yes you can apply but it would not be considered a model program if it is not on the Blueprints list. It is not a mandatory requirement for programs to be evidence-based, but there is a preference for these types of programs.**
