Dell Marketing L.P. is the manufacturer and reseller of computer hardware and peripherals. Dell hardware is the County standard for deskops, laptops and servers. County IT staff are certified to repair Dell hardware without voiding any warranties. Typically, desktop and laptop computers are on a 3-5 year replacement cycle and servers are on a 5-year replacement cycle.

Last year, the County spent approximately \$93,000.00 on hardware and peripherals through Dell Marketing L.P. This spend will fluctuate from year to year depending on the needs of each department.
