

The Sedgwick County Developmental Disability Organization (SCDDO) is the community developmental disability organization for Sedgwick County. SCDDO is the agency that ensures services and supports are available for children and adults with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities (I/DD).

At the SCDDO, we are a one-stop resource and a point of entry for the services available to individuals and families in need of I/DD services.

## How does the SCDDO work?

Although SCDDO is not a service provider, we do contract with the State of Kansas to ensure services are available locally. We have affiliate relationships with Community Service Providers (CSP) in Sedgwick County to ensure a wide range of essential services are available to all eligible individuals.

Below is what SCDDO does for families in Sedgwick County.

Acts as a central point of application and information for families exploring services.

Determines eligibility for the Intellectual and Developmental Disability (I/DD) system and program funding.

Maintains a network of service providers.

Reviews requests for service funding.

Manages local and state funding.

Monitors services for quality assurance purposes.

Provides public awareness of developmental disability issue
