On behalf of Risk Management, recommend to accept the insurance premium renewals as listed for an estimated total cost of \$696,577.00.

In general, the insurance market has not been profitable for the last year or so which has caused the market to increase rates and premiums. The county insurance agent has done an excellent job in negotiating a renewal that holds the line on premiums.

Risk Management recommends continuation of property insurance for the county with Alliant Insurance Services, Inc. and its PEPIP (Public Entity Property Insurance Program). This program is not licensed in the State of Kansas so a non-admitted fee must be paid. The fee is included in the premiums shown. The renewal for all other insurance coverage is recommended with the incumbent insurance companies.

Note: Excess Workers' Compensation changes: Increased SIR from \$700,000.00 to \$750,000.00. 1.99% increase in estimated annual payroll. 1.8% increase in rate.

On behalf of Fleet Management, recommend to reject the bid submitted by Shawnee Mission Ford, Inc. in the amount of \$184,328.00.

Fleet Management and the Sheriff's Office have decided to recommend rejection of the bid for the Ford Fusion Hybrids due to the costliness of Hybrids and to replace the Ford Fusion Hybrids with regular Ford Fusions. Also, the number of vehicles will be reduced from 8 to 4. The bid for Ford Fusions will be issued sometime in 2016.

Note: This recommendation was originally brought to the Board of Bids and Contracts on July 30, 2015 (who had recommended approval), and to the Board of County Commissioners on August 5, 2015, when the County Commissioners voted to refer the item back to the Board of Bids and Contracts.
