

Sedgwick County provides funding to local agencies for economic assistance that in turn provide significant contributions to our community.

Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) bus service to Oaklawn is a representative program. This service is subsidized to City of Wichita to residents who have no alternative transportation to work, school and shopping opportunities. Rider utilization of the special stop for the MTA has increased by 189 percent since 2002.


The Kansas Minority Business Council is another recipient of funding from this program and works to improve the overall opportunities for Countywide minority-owned businesses.
