The following elements are to be considered in a PCSP for a child of any age

The plan is approved by parent/guardian.			
The plan lists and describes necessary activities, training, materials, equipment, assistive technology & services needed to assist the child.			
The plan clearly identifies services the child currently receives and identifies providers as applicable.			
Health and medical needs are considered and described how they are addressed or steps to take in order to meet the need.			
Behavior support needs are considered and described how they are addressed or steps to take in order to meet the need.			
The plan considers relationships important to the child, and describes skills or needed supports in the areas of socialization and building relationships.			
The plan considers personal safety skills or training needs, appropriate to the age of the child.			
The plan identifies the family's natural and generic community resources, or there is evidence of assisting the family in identifying and developing these supports.
