C.A.L.I.N. FACTS

Introduced in February 2009, C.A.L.I.N. was designed to efficiently alert participants of stolen agricultural and construction equipment including livestock. The network is utilized to alert participants about suspicious activities around your farms and businesses as well. Information is distributed across Kansas and the surrounding states through an email and/or text distribution network.

The objective is to **quickly** inform all participants of suspicious activities and crime in their neighborhood.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

www.sedgwickcounty.org/sheriff. Click on the Crime Prevention link, then click on C.A.L.I.N. to register. Once you are added to the distribution list you will receive all alerts from C.A.L.I.N. Anyone can email calin@sedgwick.gov with information, but will not receive emails and/or text alerts until registered.



C.A.L.I.N. does not take the place of 9-1-1. If there is a situation that requires a Law Enforcement response call 9-1-1 immediately. If you have a piece of equipment stolen or if there is a suspicious character in your area call 9-1-1. The final step is to email a detailed Synopsis of what occurred to calin@sedgwick.gov.

GUIDELINES FOR STOLEN ITEMS

- Include when event occurred
- What was stolen
- Color
- Brand
- Year
- VIN
- Serial number
- Identifying marks
- Picture of item, if available
- Suspect information

GUIDELINES FOR SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

- Describe all individuals involved
- Height, weight, hair, eyes
- Clothing
- Vehicle description
- Color
- Make
- Model
- Tag number
- Describe what the suspect was doing that caught your attention.
- Location
