**A RESOLUTION AMENDING CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE II, DIVISION 3,
SECTION 16-53 OF THE SEDGWICK COUNTY CODE INCREASING PROGRAM
FEES FOR THE SEDGWICK COUNTY DIVISION OF CORRECTIONS**

WHEREAS, the Sedgwick County Board of Commissioners is statutorily responsible for implementing and operating under a comprehensive plan for correctional services provided within the community pursuant to K.S.A. 75-5292, 75-52,102, and 75-52,110;

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Sedgwick County Division of Corrections to provide appropriate and necessary community-based supervision services to offenders who remain in the community;

WHEREAS, Adult and Juvenile Intensive Supervision Programs are an integral component of the Sedgwick County comprehensive plan for correctional services;

WHEREAS, the cost of correctional services is borne by the community at large, it is important for purposes of offender accountability that individuals receiving these services bear a portion of the cost of these services.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of January, 2000, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County enacted Resolution No. 5-2000 amending the Sedgwick County Community Corrections Program pursuant to K.S.A. 19-101a; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to amend Section 16-53 (a) of the Sedgwick County Code pertaining to the Residential Services Room/Board Formula to change reimbursement from a room and board fee formula to a standard daily fee. No other provision in 16-53 shall be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

SECTION I. Section 16-53 (a) of the Sedgwick County Code is hereby amended and shall read as follows.

(a) *Fee:* A room and board fee for reimbursement to the Sedgwick County Division of Corrections to defray the costs of residential program housing expenses incurred on behalf of its clients is hereby adopted. The residential services room and board fee for clients of the county corrections facility shall be as follows:

- (1) Daily Room and Board Charge: Residential clients will be assessed an amount of \$15.00 per day, for daily room and board, to commence the day they enter the program.

SECTION II. Publication and Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective upon its passage and publication in the official county newspaper. This resolution shall be published in the Sedgwick County Code.
