WICHITA, KAN. – A man was sentenced to more than 10 years in prison for a series of burglaries and robberies in Wichita.

Timothy Kelly, 58 of Wichita, pleaded guilty in August to two robberies, two thefts and 16 burglaries. The crimes occurred between September of 2016 and July of 2017.

On Friday, District Court Judge Faith Maughan sentenced Kelly to 130 months for all the crimes. Kelly was also ordered to pay \$3,896.00 in restitution to the victims of the two robberies which occurred at the Shirkmere Apartments, 256 N. Topeka, in June of this year. In each robbery, an apartment resident was attacked and injured by Kelly.

The burglaries involved several Dollar General, Dollar Tree, Family Dollar and Save-A-Lot locations in the Wichita area. Most of the break-ins occurred at night and were accomplished by smashing a window. Losses included candy, cigarettes, batteries, meat, chips, and other small items.

The Wichita Police Department investigated the cases.
