Wichita, Kansas – A woman who admitted she drove a teenage girl from Lawrence to Wichita to have sex with men for money has been sentenced to prison. District Judge Terry Pullman sentenced LaDeisha Brown, 21 of Wichita, to 51 months. In January the woman pled guilty to attempted aggravated human trafficking and two counts of commercial sexual exploitation of a child.

The 15 year old victim told law enforcement officers she rode with Brown and Jaquett Dunbar to Wichita after she ran away from a group home in Lawrence on February 8, 2016. Dunbar, 26 of Wichita, was sentenced to 71 months in prison last October.

A man accused of paying to have sex with the victim at a hotel in downtown Wichita faces trial later this month.

The District Attorney requested a prison sentence of 71 months for Brown. The Judge granted a downward durational departure based on the defendant's age, her lack of criminal history and that Ms. Brown herself had been raised in the foster care system.
