## Sedgwick County Reference Guide for Precinct and District Names

City of Wichita precincts have a 3-digit number plus a leading zero. The first number of precinct is the City Council district the precinct is in. Example: Precinct 0311 is in City Council District 3.

Township and Second Class City designations use the abbreviations shown below. Some are divided into precincts indicated by a number following the abbreviation. Example: AT01.

Most of the Demographics Reports will show a decimal point and a 2-digit number after the precinct name or number. This designation is to track districts that can be contained within a precinct or can cross precinct boundary lines. If an entire precinct has the same districts, the only 2-digit number after the precinct will be .01. If, for example, the precinct contains two school districts, one of the school districts will have a 2-digit number of .01 following the precinct designation while the other will be .02.
