### BACK-TO-SCHOOL VACCINATIONS AND SPECIAL CLINIC

(Sedgwick County, Kan.) – It's nearly time for school enrollment and children need certain vaccinations to attend school. Don't wait; get your child vaccinated now!

Required vaccinations for the 2013-2014 school year:

DTAP	5 doses
Polio	4 doses
MMR	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella	2 doses for grades K-4 and 7-9 1 dose for grades 5-6 and 10-12
HIB	4 doses for children younger than age 5
Pneumococcal	4 doses for children younger than age 5
Hepatitis A	2 doses for children younger than age 5
Tdap	1 dose for grades 7-12

The Sedgwick County Health Department will offer a special Saturday vaccination clinic from **9 a.m. to noon August 3** at 2716 W. Central, Wichita.

Vaccinations are free to uninsured children age 18 and younger, and proof of income is required. Most insurance is accepted, including Medicare and Medicaid. **Please bring your child's shot record to the clinic.**
