ADDENDUM #1

The following is to ensure that vendors have complete information prior to submitting a proposal. Here are some clarifications regarding the proposal for one (1), **ALL-WHEEL DRIVE**, **ARTICULATED CENTER**, **WHEELED LOADER** for Fleet Management.

Questions and/or statements of clarification are in **bold** font, answers to specific questions are *italicized*.

1. 5.9.1 (a) Operating Weight: Will you accept 51,175 lbs?

Answer: Yes. 51,175 lbs is acceptable.

2. 5.9.1 (c) Is the Operating height measured from the top of the bucket to the ground?

Answer: Yes. Measurement is from the top of the bucket at fully raised position to ground, minimum measurement must meet or exceed 19'.

3. 5.9.2 (c) Is horsepower rating of 262 acceptable?

Answer: No. 272 hp at rated rpm net is a minimum requirement.

4. 5.9.2 (h) Are self cleaning fans that do not swing out acceptable?

Answer: We will accept a non swing out fan, but prefer swing out.

5. 5.9.3 (f) Is a reverse speed of 16.5 mph acceptable?

Answer: A reverse speeds of 16.5 mph is acceptable, but prefer 22 mph.

6. 5.9.4 (c) Is a lock up torque converter with automatic limited slip differentials acceptable?

Answer: Yes, a lock up torque converter with automatic limited slip differentials is acceptable.

7. 5.9.5 (a) Are outboard breaks acceptable?

Answer: No. Breaks must remain inboard.

8. 5.9.7 (c) Are 900cca batteries acceptable?

Answer: No. 12V batteries, each with a minimum of 930 cca is required.

9. 5.9.9 (a) (3) Is a bucket breakout force of 38,984 lbs. acceptable?

Answer: Yes. A 38,984 lbs. bucket breakout force is acceptable.

10. 5.9.10 (n) Are cab window defrosters acceptable instead of electric rear defrosters?

Answer: Yes, defroster on rear window is acceptable.
