## REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #14-0032 ENCLOSED CAB, MOWING TRACTORS

## ADDENDUM #1

April 2, 2013

The following is to ensure that vendors have complete information prior to submitting a proposal. Here are some clarifications regarding the proposal for four (4), ENCLOSED CAB, MOWING TRACTORS for Fleet Management.

Questions and/or statements of clarification are in **bold** font, answers to specific questions are *italicized*.

- 1. What is the deadline for delivery? Answer: Delivery is preferred by September 2014.
- 2. May multiple proposals be submitted? Answer: Yes, as long as they meet specifications.
- *3.* **Specification 5.13.1 calls 17.6 GPM, is 15 GPM acceptable?** *Answer:* No, 17.6 GPM is the minimum acceptable.
- 4. Correction to Specification 5.13.2: Factory mounted three spool remote control valves with quick couplers furnished and mounted within easy reach of operator. Minimum of three (3) valves shall have float detent position.

*Comment: Minimum of Two* (2) *valves was replaced by minimum of three* (3) *valves.* 

- 5. Specification 5.15.10: Do the four (4) strobe lights need to be LED? Answer: Yes. Four (4) strobe lights need to be protected or inside the roof. These strobe lights are in addition to the factory hazard lights. LED lights cannot replace factory hazard lights.
- 6. Specification 5.15.11: A front weight bracket may be substituted for a grill guard. Do you want weights? *Answer: No, we do not want weights.*
- 7. Specification 5.16.1: What type of training is required? Answer: Operator, mechanic, and safety training is required. Training is only required if equipment is purchased.
- 8. Specification 5.16.2: Manufacturer will only provide diagnostic software, information, or training to their dealers. Is this acceptable?

Answer: No. Diagnostic software and training is required to maintain within the shop.

## 9. Specification 5.17.1 & 2: Are manuals in CD/DVD form acceptable?

Answer: Yes, manuals in CD/DVD form are acceptable.

Firms interested in submitting a proposal, must respond with complete information and all supplementary materials and **deliver on or before 1:45 p.m. (CDT), Tuesday, April 8, 2013.** Late proposals will not be accepted and will not receive consideration for final award.

Vendors are responsible for checking the website and **acknowledging any addendum on the proposal response form.**
