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REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #14-0069 FIRING RANGE BERM REMEDIATION ADDENDUM #1

August 20, 2014

The following is to ensure that vendors have complete information prior to submitting a proposal. Here are some clarifications regarding the proposal for the FIRING RANGE BERM REMEDIATION, for the Sedgwick County Sheriff.

Questions and/or statements of clarification are in **bold** font, and answers to specific questions are *italicized*.

1. How much time each day will we have access to the facility to complete the job? The vendor awarded the contract will work directly with the Range Staff to negotiate a mutually agreed schedule.

2. Can you please explain what Payment to Sedgwick County means in Section 14, Page 9 of the RFP?

Sedgwick County will not be issuing payment for the Berm Remediation. The successful vendor awarded the contract will retain the proceeds of any recycled lead removed from the range less a percentage of such proceeds, which shall be returned to the County. The proceeds from the recycled lead minus the County's percentage will serve as payment for this project. The County will require a copy of the receipt after the material is recycled for verification purposes.

3. What is the majority of what is shot here?

9mm ammunition is the majority of what is shot here. However, everything from .38 caliber to .223 and shotgun slugs are used, just not in large quantities

4. What is the width of the bays?

The bays are approximately 6 feet in width.

5. How many bays are there?

There are 50 bays total.

6. How much dirt will have to be replaced in the berm?

The existing grade of the berm from top to bottom must be matched so the face of the berm is the same angle and grade across the entire face. In other words, the berm face that has been remediated should not bulge outward (convex), nor should it be sunken in (concave).

Firms interested in submitting a proposal, must respond with complete information and all supplementary materials and **deliver on or before 1:45 p.m. (CDT), Tuesday, August 26, 2014.** Late proposals will not be accepted and will not receive consideration for final award.
