

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #15-0034 SIX WHEEL BROOM STREET SWEEPER

ADDENDUM #2

The following is to ensure that vendors have complete information prior to submitting a bid. Here are some clarifications regarding the bid for a SIX WHEEL BROOM STREET SWEEPER, for Public Work's use.

Questions and/or statements of clarification are in **bold** font, answers to specific questions are *italicized*.

- 1. The request for a RUBBER TIRE EXCAVATOR has been revised from a request for bid to a Request for Proposal. It differs from a Request for Bid or Quotation in that the County is seeking a solution, not a bid or quotation meeting firm specifications for the lowest price. As such, the lowest price proposed will not guarantee an award recommendation. As defined in Charter Resolution No. 65, Competitive Sealed Proposals will be evaluated based upon criteria formulated around the most important features of the product(s) and/or service(s), of which quality, testing, references, service, availability or capability, may be overriding factors, and price may not be determinative in the issuance of a contract or award. The proposal evaluation criteria should be viewed as standards that measure how well a vendor's approach meets the desired requirements and needs of the County. Criteria that will be used and considered in evaluation for award are set forth in this document. The County will thoroughly review all proposals received. A Purchase Order/Contract will be awarded to a qualified vendor submitting the best proposal. Sedgwick County reserves the right to select, and subsequently recommend for award, the proposed service(s) and/or product(s) which best meets its required needs, quality levels and budget constraints.
- 2. It is the intent to purchase a DRY FILTERED WATERLESS DUST SYSTEM, any other configurations or systems will not be considered.
- 3. Page 2, 5.10: Can inflation be included for each year? Answer: Yes. Include inflation percentages for 2016 and 2017 if price is not firm for three years
- 4. Page 3, 1.0 Revised: Chassis shall be the current model year. *Replaced: "2014" with "current model year"*

5. Page 4, 5.5 Delete

Removed: "Truck instruments shall include warning lights for battery, and cab latch to make sure the cab is locked in position"

6. Page 6, 5.4 Revised: Engine shall utilize a dedicated battery with no less than 925 CCA *Replaced: "950 CCA" with "925 CCA"*

- 7. Page 6, 5.5: Will you accept oil cool? Answer: No. Only antifreeze is acceptable.
- 8. Page 6, 5.6: Will you accept 60 amps on back side? Answer: Yes. 60 amps on back side is acceptable
- 9. Page 7, 7.9: Is a plastic hood acceptable? Answer: No. A plastic hood is not acceptable
- 10. Page 7, 6.10 Revised Sweeper shall be equipped with electric or hydraulic side broom..... Replaced: "electric side broom" with "electric or hydraulic side broom"
- 11. Page 7, 7 Revise: The main broom shall not be less than 58 inches long and not less than 34 inches in diameter.

Replace: "...60 inches long and not less than 35 inches..." with "...58 inches long and not less than 34 inches..."

12. Page 8, 9.10 Revised: Delete third and fourth sentence.

Removed: "Non-slide shifting hopper designs will not be acceptable and reason for rejection of bid. A large dump door will not be sufficient for this side-shifting requirement"

13. Page 8, 9.16 Revised, 1st sentence: Inside of the hopper shall be coated with a Lifeliner, or equal or better than Lifeliner, sweeper hopper coating
Bankaged: "Lifeliner, "to "Lifeliner or equal or better than Lifeliner,"

Replaced: "...Lifeliner..." to "...Lifeliner, or equal or better than Lifeliner..."

- 14. Page 8, 10.4 Revised: Tank capacity shall be not less than 300 gallons Replaced: "315 gallons" with "300 gallons"
- 15. Page 8, 11.1 Revised: Reservoir capacity shall be not less than 35 gallons with outside level indicator. *Replaced: "40 gallons" with "35 gallons"*
- *16.* Page 9, 11.2 Revised: Sweep component pump shall be three section or variable displacement directly driven.

Replaced: "three section" to "three section or variable displacement"

17. Add: SELECTION CRITERIA.

The selection process will be based on the responses to this Request for Proposal and any interviews required verifying the ability of proposer to provide services in accord with this document. A committee will evaluate each proposer's response as determined by meeting the following criteria (ranked in no particular order):

- Demonstrate clearly and completely your ability and capacity to meet all Request for Proposal Conditions and miscellaneous instructions as outlined herein, and the clarity, completeness and comprehensiveness of the proposal
- Meeting or exceeding all provider qualification requirements and/or specifications as outlined herein
- Proposing the equipment described herein with the most advantageous and prudent methodology to the County
- Purchase price
- Warranty and availability of equipment

Upon review of the proposals a "demonstration session" may be required and scheduled to evaluate the overall performance of each short-listed proposer at the demonstration site. It is essential that you be available for this demonstration upon request. The County will evaluate the following:

- Operator Rating a County employee will operate the equipment to determine ease of handling and convenience, e.g., location of controls, smoothness of machine operation and ergonomic features
- Technical rating County Fleet personnel will evaluate the ease of routine service and maintenance

- Maintenance cost that will be required of the County based on the results of the technical rating
- Cost
- Availability
- Safety Features
- Warranty

Those submitting a proposal do so entirely at their own expense. There is no expressed or implied obligation by Sedgwick County to reimburse any individual or firm for any cost incurred in preparing or submitting proposals, providing additional information when requested by Sedgwick County or for participating in any selection interviews.

County reserves the right to reject any proposal, determine any irregularities, and make final determination for award.

No negotiations, decisions, or actions will be initiated by any firm as a result of any verbal discussion with any County employee during the request for proposal process. Sedgwick County reserves the right to select the service(s) and/or provider(s), and subsequently recommend for award, the proposed services that best meets required needs, quality levels, and budget constraints.

18. Section 6: Can the delivery date be extended?

Answer: Yes. County desires to have orders delivered no later than December 30, 2015. Orders delivered after December 30, 2015 shall be assessed with liquidated damages in the amount of \$250.00 per day.

19. Attached, please find the sign-in sheet from the pre-proposal meeting held on March 25, 2015.

Firms interested in submitting a proposal, must respond with complete information and all supplementary materials and **deliver on or before 1:45 p.m. CDT, Tuesday, April 14, 2015.** Responses must be <u>sealed and marked on the lower left-hand corner with the firm name and address, proposal number, and proposal due date</u>. Late or incomplete responses will not be accepted and will not receive consideration for final award. The time stamp clock in the Purchasing Department will determine the time of receipt.

Proposal responses will be acknowledged and read into record at bid opening which will occur at 2:00 p.m., CDT on the due date. No information other than the respondent's name will be disclosed at bid opening.
