PROPOSAL

1. The undersigned bidder (the "Bidder"), proposes to furnish all materials, labor, supplies, equipment and incidentals necessary to construct Sedgwick County Project No. 642-16-3150; Bridge on 95th St. South between 151st & 167th Streets West (B476) in accordance with the Contract Documents.

2. If this Proposal is accepted, Bidder agrees to execute and deliver to County a contract in accordance with the Contract Documents and within ten days of notice of the award to Bidder. Bidder agrees that the bid deposit given concurrently herewith shall become the property of County in the event Bidder fails to execute and deliver such contract within said time. In the further event of such failure, Bidder shall be liable for County's actual damages that exceed the amount of the bid deposit.

3. The Notice to Proceed shall be issued no sooner than October 9, 2017, but it shall be issued no later than October 23, 2017. Bidder agrees to complete the work according to the Contract Documents within one hundred five (105) working days.

4. Time is of the essence in the Bidder's performance. Bidder agrees that County's damages would be difficult or impossible to predict in the event of a default in the performance hereof; and it is therefore agreed that if Bidder defaults in the performance of the Contract Documents, Bidder shall be liable for payment of the sums stipulated in the Contract Documents as liquidated damages, and not as a penalty.

5. Bidder hereby certifies that it has carefully examined all of the Contract Documents for the Project, that it has inspected the location of the Project and understands the nature and scope of the work to be done; and that this Proposal is based on the terms, conditions, and requirements of the Contract Documents. Bidder agrees that the performance time specified is a reasonable time, having carefully considered the nature and scope of the Project as aforesaid.

6. Bidder's proposed sureties and insurers are subject to the approval of County.

7. Bidder certifies that this Proposal is submitted without collusion, fraud or misrepresentation as to other Bidders, so that all bids for the Project will result from free, open and competitive bidding among all Bidders.
