

GENERAL NOTES

Pavement Marking

All pavement marking shall conform to the requirements of the Kansas Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for State Road and Bridge Construction (2015), except no glass beads shall be required.

Project Work Schedule

Due to the high visibility of this project, the Contractor shall take extra care to coordinate any changes of schedule with the Engineer and Sedgwick County Zoo. The zoo expects all parking lots to be at capacity for an event on August 5, 2017 and as such has requested that all lots be available to the public for parking. Additionally, the annual Zoobilee is scheduled for September 9, 2017 and all work must be completed by this date (1 week after the calendar completion date.)

Millings

Millings shall remain the property of Sedgwick County. All millings shall be clean; hauling equipment shall be cleaned before use. Sedgwick County Millings shall be transported as salvable material by the Contractor to the Sedgwick County West Yard located at 4701 South West Street, Wichita, KS 67217. Millings are not required to be weighed prior to transport. All materials, labor, equipment, and incidentals necessary to do this work shall be considered SUBSIDIARY to the lump sum price bid for "Transporting Salvageable Materials".
