On the recommendation of Joe Thomas, on behalf of Public Works, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the low bid from Bridges Inc. in the amount of \$235,200.00**. Linda Kizzire seconded the motion. The motion pass unanimously.

Project B443 is a streambank stabilization project along the Ninescah River at 151st St. W. The river bends at this location and the north riverbank has been eroding for many years. This is a natural process, but there are rural residential properties and a County bridge that are negatively affected by the erosion.

The project will use natural stone to reinforce the toe of the bank and create weirs that will reduce water velocities and redirect the water flow towards the center of the river. Over time, the river will return to its previous location closer to the center of the bridge.

This project will be very environmentally friendly. This section of the river is designated critical habitat for three state-listed fish. The planted vegetation and the use of natural stone will create habitat for these fishes as well as other native wildlife.

Question was asked: Has this vendor performed any prior work for Public Works? Yes, this vendor has done projects for Public Works and has performed very well. David Spears of Public Works noted that 11 companies had taken out plans for this project with 6 companies providing bids.
