The recommendation of Purchasing and the Health Department is to accept the low proposal from Trailerlogic / MRS, for a cost of \$36,586.25.

A review committee consisting of Anna Meyerhoff, Regional Forensic Science Center; Kendra Nguyen, Health Department, and Gunda Angelica, Purchasing, evaluated the proposals and the decision to choose Trailerlogic was reached unanimously.

Note: The Mass Fatality Morgue Trailer increases capacity to retrieve remains in the event of a mass fatality disaster in South Central Kansas. This trailer is being purchased by the Sedgwick County Health Department using Metropolitan Medical Response System funding and will be housed and maintained by the Sedgwick County Regional Forensic Science Center (RFSC). The trailer can hold up to 20 remains in a temperature-controlled environment. The rolling racks allow for the remains to be unloaded directly from the trailer to the morgue at the RFSC, increasing the ability to handle mass fatality situations at the RFSC as opposed to having to store remains at another location.
