On behalf of Purchasing and Household Hazardous Waste, recommend to **accept the bid from Kansas Fence Co., Inc. in the amount of \$46,353.00.**

This work will include adding drive-through and walk-through gates to 2 sides of the building that will be controlled electronically and have manual backup. Similar work was done at the Stillwell complex previously.

When other vendors were contacted to see why they did not bid, some were too busy for the work and others commented that they did not want to deal with the electrical sub-contracting. The county does not wish to have the electrical work done separately, as it could result in issues between the fence contractor and the county selected electrical contractor if issues arise. Having all of the work done under one contractor using an electrical sub-contractor will alleviate those issues.
