On the recommendation of Britt Rosencutter, on behalf of the Division of Health and Human Services, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the proposals and execute service provider agreements for annual spends as listed above with Youth for Christ - McAdams Academy for \$115,000.00, Kansas Legal Services for \$25,760.00, Youth for Christ - City Works Program for \$60,000.00, The Pando Initiative, Inc. for \$41,854.00, Mental Health Association of South Central Kansas for \$54,300.00, Tiospaye, Inc. dba Higher Ground for \$95,000.00, Episcopal Social Services for \$79,286.00, and Ember Hope for \$187,952.00 for a contract period of three (3) years.** Linda Kizzire seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A committee consisting of Talaya Schwartz, Brenda Gutierrez - COMCARE , Jeannette Livingston - CDDO, Tim Kaufman, Director , Division of Health and Human Services, Jodi Tronsgard, Mario Salinas - Department of Corrections, Marty Hughes - Division of Finance and Britt Rosencutter - Purchasing evaluated all proposal responses, based on the goals of the Committee overseeing prevention and early intervention services, proposal content, cost, qualifications, experience of the agency, and the availability of the agency to work with those being served.

Sedgwick County is allocating approximately \$662,000.00 annually in support of prevention and early intervention programs targeted to youth at risk for juvenile delinquency.
