On the recommendation of Kristen McGovern, on behalf of Public Works, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the low bid from Cornejo & Sons, LLC, in the amount of \$550,064.19.** Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Bond Tekk is a dense-graded BM-1(bituminous mix) of finer aggregate which creates a 1" overlay for a smoother driving surface. It will be used to fill ruts and revitalize surfaces for approximately 8.1 of miles selected county roads.

Question - Are we sure they understand the scope of work? David Spears explained there are two reasons: 1) There is a new bidder, Flint Hills Materials. There is a bid list and the competition saw this new bidder and we believe that made their prices competitive. 2) The State of Kansas this year, instead of 1200 miles of this type of work, will be 200 miles. In Sedgwick County we will do 120 miles. Vendors are competing for less work than the previous year.
