On the recommendation of Kara Kingsley, on behalf the Division of Corrections, Jennifer Dombaugh moved to **accept the proposal from University of Kansas School of Medicine - Wichita Medical Practice Association for an annual cost of \$240,056.00 and establish contract pricing for three (3) years with two (2) one (1) year options to renew.** Tim Kaufman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

A committee comprised of Mario Salinas and Steven Stonehouse - Corrections, Brenda Gutierrez-Varela - COMCARE and Kara Kingsley - Purchasing reviewed and evaluated the response and unanimously agreed to recommend the University of Kansas School of Medicine - Wichita Medical Practice Association. This contract will provide medical services to Juvenile Detention Facility, Juvenile Residential Facility and the Sedgwick County Youth Program.

Vendors who did not submit a response were contacted and asked why they choose not to respond. The reasons given were that the solicitation was outside of their area of expertise, are currently too busy to add additional clients and staffing issues.

University of Kansas School of Medicine - Wichita Medical Practice Association is the current contracted vendor for these services.

Tim Kaufman – Can someone help me understand how this is priced? Is this a fee for service with a cap or is it all inclusive?

Mario Salinas, Administrative Manager for Division of Corrections – The pricing is broken down by a full time physician that is available once a week that supervises the medical services program and they provide an APRN and LPN five days a week and they have on-call services and they also included pricing as far as on-call services and any missed billing.
