WICHITA, KAN. – A second man has been sentenced following the sexual attack of two teenage girls in Wichita. On Tuesday, Judge Stephen Ternes sentenced Roderick Martin, 57 of Wichita, to 214 months in prison.

On February 9th, Martin pled guilty to two counts of commercial sexual exploitation of a child, two counts of kidnapping, four counts of sexual exploitation of a child and one count of aggravated indecent liberties with a child.

November 4, 2015, two runaway girls, 15 and 16 years old, were walking near 21st and Hydraulic in Wichita when they were offered a ride by Jordan Lewis. Once in the car, the man pulled a gun and drove the girls to a house in the 2400 block of north Piatt where the girls were sexually assaulted by Lewis and Martin. The younger girl escaped the house the next morning and ran to a neighbor to get help. Both men were arrested the next day.

On December 21st, Jordan Lewis, 40 of Wichita, was sentenced to 330 months in prison by Judge Kevin O'Connor.
