Recommend to accept the proposal from Seventh Direction Inc. for substance treatment services.

The first grant period (June 2018 to December 2018) is estimated to cost \$14,928.87. This seven month period will serve as a baseline for the cost of services for clients. The Department of Corrections (DoC) is estimating \$4,000 for each of the successive two years (SFY 19 and SFY 20) for a total of \$22,928.87. DoC is projecting the vendor will bill Medicaid and this will assume more of the cost.

A review committee comprised of Christine Collins-Thoman, Kevin Cocking, and Stacy Garrett - Department of Corrections, Jeannette Livingston - COMCARE and Paul Regehr - Purchasing, evaluated all proposals based on criteria set forth in the RFP. References were checked and all proposals were scored. Seventh Direction, Inc. received the highest score and was unanimously chosen.

The substance treatment provider will complete assessments, and individual and group treatment services. The location of services will be in the Division of Corrections Juvenile Field Services offices Evening Reporting Center at 3803 E. Harry in Wichita, KS.
