On the recommendation of Josh Lauber, on behalf of Public Works, Richard Powell moved to **accept the bid from Traffic Control Services, Inc. in the amount of \$614,934.90**. Linda Kizzire seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

This project includes pavement marking for approximately 216.75 miles of selected county roads.

Questions and Answers

Russell Leeds: Do we have any questions from the board?

Linda Kizzire: Why did we only get one bid?

Jim Weber: There are other contractors that provide this service. In fact, one of them I know is a subcontractor on some of the other paving jobs that we're doing. We don't know. This is a lot of going out and painting.

Linda Kizzire: Okay, and there's no chance of us getting another paint truck?

Jim Weber: We gave that up during budget cuts a long time ago. That would involve adding two people and the equipment is pretty expensive to buy into, so bid includes everything. I can tell you that this year's unit price is slightly lower than last year's price. We do a north half and a south half and this is the bigger one. So the total price, if you would compare them you would say that's a lot higher. But the actual unit price for painting is lower.
