**A RESOLUTION AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE IV, DIVISION 2
OF THE SEDGWICK COUNTY CODE**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas adopted Sedgwick County Resolution 137-2015 which renamed the “Sedgwick County Mental Retardation and Physical Disabilities Advisory Board” to the “Sedgwick County Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Advisory Board”;

WHEREAS, said resolution changed only the references to the advisory board name;

WHEREAS, in addition to said revisions, references in Sedgwick County Code Sections 14-111 and 14-113 should be changed from “mental retardation” and “physical disability” to “intellectual disability” and “developmentally disabled.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

SECTION I. Sedgwick County Code, Chapter 14, Article IV, Division 2, Section 14-111 and Section 14-113, as currently adopted, shall be rescinded and the following shall be adopted:

**DIVISION 2. SEDGWICK COUNTY INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL
DISABILITIES ADVISORY BOARD**

Sec. 14-111. – Membership; appointment and term of members.

- (a) The board of county commissioners shall appoint a Sedgwick County Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities advisory board, the members of which shall be consumers of mental health services or representatives of mental health consumer groups and shall include family members of mentally ill persons and, as nearly as possible, representative of public health, the medical profession, the judiciary, public welfare, hospitals, mental health, and intellectual and developmental disability organizations, and education, rehabilitation, labor, business and civic groups. The board shall consist of fifteen (15) members, who shall serve at the pleasure of the board of county commissioners for terms of four (4) years from the date of appointment.
- (b) Each county commissioner shall appoint three (3) members to the advisory board. If the commissioner appointing a board member leaves office for any reason, the term shall expire, except that a member may serve until a successor has been duly appointed.

- (c) In the event of the death, resignation or disqualification of any member, such member's successor shall be appointed as provided in this section to fill only the unexpired term caused by such vacancy.

Sec. 14-113. – Duties.

The duties of the Sedgwick County Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities advisory board shall be to make recommendations to the board of county commissioners prior to the adoption of the annual plan and budget for intellectual and developmental disability programs. The advisory board shall further assist and be called upon by the board of county commissioners to evaluate programs and services for the intellectual and developmentally disabled residents of the county and provide specific recommendations at the request of the board of county commissioners.

SECTION II. Severability.

Should any section, clause or provision of this resolution be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this resolution as a whole, or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION III. Publication and effective date.

The County Clerk is directed to publish this resolution once in the official county newspaper. This resolution shall become effective upon approval.

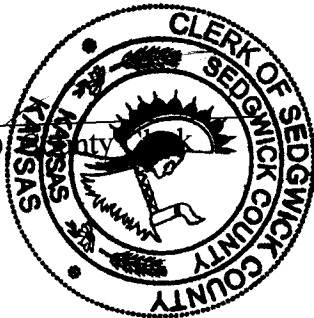
