On February 19, 2019, the PREA Committee conducted a review of all substantiated and unsubstantiated case for the year 2018. The substantiated cases that were: 18S000127 and 18S000067. In reviewing each of these cases the committee determined policy was followed, nothing occurred to be able to prevent the incidents was from happening. There were no signs to make an indication in either incident a sexual abuse would occur.

The review of both cases the committee did not find any indication either incident was motivated by race; ethnicity; gender identity; lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status; or gang affiliation; or was motivated or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incident occurred the physical barriers in the area had no effect on the abuse, the staffing level was adequate and there is no need for extra cameras.

The unsubstantiated cases were: 18S00999, 18S010562, 18S010334, and 18S009388. In reviewing each of these cases the committee determined policy was followed, nothing occurred to be able to prevent the incidents was from happening. There were no signs to make an indication in either incident a sexual abuse would occur.

The review of both cases the committee did not find any indication either incident was motivated by race; ethnicity; gender identity; lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status; or gang affiliation; or was motivated or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incident occurred the physical barriers in the area had no effect on the abuse, the staffing level was adequate and there is no need for extra cameras.
