Introductions and Announcements – Glenda Martens explained new process for board appointments. Announced that appointments will be made next week.

Approval of Minutes from meeting January 9, 2020 – *A motion to approve the Minutes from the January 9, 2020 meeting was made by Kevin O'Conner, seconded by Ann Swegle and unanimously approved.*

Update – Lori Gibbs announced that they continue to work with KDOC and they have a goal of having a narrative done by end of next week. Jay Holmes spoke about intervention procedures and documentation that are being implemented. Jay Holmes announced that the Behavioral Health grant instructions were sent out last week.

Program Updates:

ADP data available in meeting packet

Jay Holmes recognized Dan Maier and Matt Deitchler for their work on Odyssey Project

Jay Holmes conducted a PowerPoint presentation of an overall update for all programs:

Drug Court – 221 clients for calendar year 2019, 52% successful discharge, 10% increase over past 3 years. Successful completers spent approximately 712 days in the program.

Pretrial – Making progress on implementation of Pretrial Risk Assessment instrument. Adjustment was made to manage the increase in population.

Residential – Increased from 55-71 which equates to 24% ADP. Successful completions have increased by 4%. Since program's inception, it has served over 1,000 clients. Continue to have ongoing wait list for female Work Release beds. Increase in Level I referrals.

AISP – Gang Mapping Process is fully active – 7 current gang members.

Goals for 2020 – Get the Batterers Intervention Program up and running.

Other Business- Glenda Martens announced that DOC will have their Employee of the Year Award on 03/05/20. Nominees were announced to the board. Glenda also announced that she was asked to be on the Kansas Sentencing Commission.

Kelli Grant announced that she served on the Panel for A Raisin in the Sun last week. Kelli thanked Corrections for their large presence and informed of upcoming events.

Glenda handed out SCDOC pins to board members.
