The Kansas statute allows any person arrested in this state to petition the court for an expungement of such arrest record if: the arrest occurred because of mistaken identity; a court has found that there was no probable cause for the arrest; the petitioner was found not guilty in court proceedings; or the expungment would be in the best interest of justice and (A) charges have been dismissed or (B) no charges have been or are likely to be filed. (K.S.A 22-2410)

If an attorney is representing you, your attorney will prepare the necessary documents to petition for expungement of the arrest. If you are proceeding without an attorney (*pro se*) you will need to follow these instructions carefully.

The following documents are to be used in preparing the expungement pleadings. The forms include a personal information report, petition, affidavit and an order of expungement. You can fill out the forms online and print them to be submitted with your expungement packet.

When you have completed the forms, please send one copy of the affidavit, one copy of the petition, one copy of the personal information report, and the orginal of the order of expungement to the Office of the District Attorney at the downtown address shown above. Once the required record check has been completed and the attorney has reviewed the file, a decision will be made as to eligibility for expungement. If we agree to the expungement, the attorney will sign the Order and return it to you for further handling. At that time, you will need to obtain the judge's signature and then file the petition, affidavit and the order with the Clerk of Criminal Court. Please note that the judge's signature must be on the order before it can be filed with the clerk. The clerk's office will advise you regarding how many copies of each pleading they require.

If this office decides to object to the expungement, you will be so notified and the documents you submitted will be returned to you. You can then decide whether you wish to file the petition, schedule a hearing on the petition, and present your request to the Court.

In preparing the petition, affidavit, and order, all information presently set out in the forms should be contained in the original documents that are prepared. The information is needed by this office in conducting the record check and is also needed by the various law enforcement agencies which must identify the specific event which led to the arrest. Since the records are maintained by name and date of arrest and other identifying information, all of the information requested must be provided. A separate petition, affidavit, and order must be completed for each arrest you are petitioning the court to expunge.
