SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review

On October 30, 2020, the PREA Committee conducted a review of eight unsubstantiated cases. The unsubstantiated cases were: 20S001010, 20S001011, 20S002376, 20S01031, 20S001645, 20S003189, 20S003237 and 20S003327. There were no substantiated cases.


In reviewing each of the unsubstantiated cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred to prevent the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication in either circumstance a sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee did not find any indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status. The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse. The staffing level was adequate, and there is no need for extra cameras.

There was only one suggestion brought up about case 20S003327. The camera angle did not provide enough view to see if the inmate went into another inmate's cell. Repositioning the camera for a better view area was suggested.

I have nothing else to report at this time.
