Hunter Health COVID-19 Vaccines

Definition: Beginning **Tuesday, January 19**, Hunter Health offers Native American/Alaskan Indian individuals ages 55+ COVID-19 vaccinations by appointment only. Because we are the only Urban Indian Health Clinic in Kansas, vaccinations to these individuals are our priority. American Indian and Alaska Native people have died in connection with COVID-19 at nearly twice the rate of white people in a sample of 14 states, according to a new analysis published by the CDC (Source: <https://bit.ly/3nDi01X>).

Examples of Groups Included:

- Native American/Alaskan Indian Hunter Health patients age 55+
- Native American/Alaskan Indian individuals age 55+ who are not currently Hunter Health patients.
- Must be able to provide Native American verification.

How to Schedule Your Vaccine:

- Appointments must be made to receive the vaccination. Walk-ins will not be accepted. Call (316) 262-2415 to schedule. You do not need to be a patient of Hunter Health to participate.
