



Make a Plan for your COVID-19 Vaccine

Follow these recommended steps when it is time to get your COVID-19 vaccine. Remember, everyone who wishes to get a COVID-19 vaccine will have the opportunity to be vaccinated as supply comes in.

Step 1: Register to receive your vaccine.

- If you have questions about how the vaccine may interact with your medical condition and medications you take, please contact your primary care physician before scheduling an appointment
- Register ahead of time online at www.sedgwickcounty.org/covid-19/vaccine/schedule/ or dial (316) 660-1029
 - A person may assist the resident by scheduling on behalf of the resident
- Choose your appointment time and make sure you plan for at least a 45-minute appointment

Step 2: Gather your documents.

- If the appointment was scheduled online, complete the Dispense Assist voucher included in the email confirmation, click "Next" then print and bring your vaccine voucher with you – or fill out the voucher when you check-in for your appointment
- Make sure you know where your driver's license, birth certificate, passport or identification with your birthdate is and have it ready to present at check-in

Step 3: Go to your vaccine appointment.

- If your appointment is at 223 S. Main, enter through the building's main entrance and park in the lots to the south of the building.
 - Parking is free – do not pay the meter
 - A guest may assist the resident at the vaccine clinic
- To check-in, please have the documents listed in Step 2 ready to share with staff checking in people
- Once you check-in, follow instructions provided at the clinic
- Remember to wear a mask and keep six feet of space between you and others at the clinic

Step 4: Document and share your experience!

- Take a selfie with your Band-Aid and share on social media using the hashtag #NotThrowingAwayMyShot, #ThisIsOurShot, or #StickItToCOVID, and tag Sedgwick County Government
 - Post prompts: How do you feel after getting your vaccine? Why did you choose to get the vaccine? What do you want others to know about your experience?
- Document any side effects from your COVID-19 using the V-safe After Vaccine Health Checker at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/safety/vsafe.html>
- Keep your vaccine card in a safe place (wallet, glove box) so you will be ready to receive your second dose of the vaccine
