“Dear Sedgwick County Commission:

Dr. Minns has stated before that if our county was below the 5% Covid positive rate for several weeks that he would consider lifting the mask mandate. According to the data on your chart (see <https://www.sedgwickcounty.org/covid-19/>), the Covid positive cases have been BELOW 2% since the beginning of January 2021. This definitely falls into the below 5% for several weeks category. Please lift the mask mandate as soon as possible. If you won't consider it for the March 10th meeting, you need to give your constituents a specific date as to when you will do this. We probably have already achieved or are very close to achieving herd immunity in our community which is why numbers are so low.
