Phase 2:

- Veterinarians
- Public Safety

- Anyone living or working in a licensed Congregate Setting
- Aviation Manufacturing Plants
- Meat Processing Plants
- Public Transportation
 - Public Ground and Air Transportation
 - K-12 School Bus Drivers vaccinated with K-12 School Personnel
- USPS + Dept. of Motor Vehicles
- Higher Education
 - WSU, WSU Tech, Friends, Newman
- Clergy or Religious Officials
- Private Packaging + Postal Delivery
 - UPS, FedEx
- Grocery Store + Food Services
 - Grocery Stores
 - Restaurant Workers
 - Food Processing
- Agriculture with high contact with others
- High Contact Retail Sales, Warehouse, Sales Outlets

Phase 3:

- People Aged 16-64 with Severe Medical Risks
 - Cancer
 - Chronic kidney disease
 - COPD
 - Down Syndrome
 - Heart conditions
 - Type 2 diabetes mellitus
 - Sickle cell disease
- Utility Workers
- Logistics Workers
- Water/Wastewater Workers
- Construction Workers
- Finance
 - Bankers
 - Brokers
 - Lenders
- Information Technology (IT)
- Communications Workers
- Apartment Leasing Staff
- DoorDash, UberEats, GrubHub Drivers
- Real Estate Agents
- Government Employees

Phase 4:

- People Aged 16-64 with Other Medical Risks
 - Asthma
 - Cystic fibrosis
 - Liver disease
 - Immunocompromised state
 - Neurologic conditions such as dementia
 - Type 1 diabetes mellitus
 - Obesity
 - Severe obesity
