A Brush Truck is a specialized vehicle used for a quicker response to fires such as car, trash, grass, and other types of fire calls that may not require large amounts of water. This vehicle carries specialized equipment and can be taken off-road for the fighting of grass and wildland fires. SCFD utilizes seven (7) of these apparatuses throughout the county, as well as assist other surrounding counties.

Vehicle being replaced:

20632 - 1992 Ford F-350 2FDKF38M8NCA94639 Points - 19.2 Mileage - 99,697

This is a replacement vehicle for SCFD 1. Surplus vehicle will be sold on Purple Wave Auction.

Questions and Answers

Linda Kizzire: Are the items on the back of this vehicle going to be moved to the new one? The apparatus?

Brian Richey: Typically when we replace a truck, we replace all of the components on the truck. There will be a new slip-in pump that hasn't been brought to you yet for approval. All of the components of the water tank, the pump will all be new on that vehicle when we get it.

Russell Leeds: I noticed in the notes this vehicle is approaching 30 years old and well exceeds the 15 point to almost 20 points on this vehicle, I assume based on wear and tear. The mileage is not that high but 30 years of use in the field as a Brush Truck. Replacement I assume is important for the safety of our fire fighters having equipment that's won't fail while they are out in the middle of a burning field.

A Rescue Squad is a specialized vehicle used for a quicker response to medical events, traffic accidents, minor fires, and other types of fire calls that may not require large amounts of water. This vehicle carries specialized medical equipment, a slip-in pump unit with water for fighting fires, Jaws of Life for extrications, and other types of equipment that may be needed. SCFD utilizes ten (10) of these apparatuses throughout the county.

Questions and Answers

Linda Kizzire: Am I safe to assume we will receive another proposal for the apparatus brought to us?

Brian Richey: Yes. We will be replacing the slip-in pump units. Most of the medical stuff will transfer from truck to truck. The bones of the truck, the pump unit in the back, and the chassis will be replaced. All of the medical and the Jaws of Life will transfer from truck to truck, so those will not be new.
