



COVID-19 Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Businesses, Non-Profits and Community Organizations

1. Where can my employees (and/or volunteers) receive a no-cost COVID-19 Test?

Testing is conducted Monday through Friday between 8:00am and 5:00pm by the Sedgwick County Health Department. Text "SC COVID TEST" to (316) 215-8313 to schedule a time for a COVID-19 test. You will receive a message notifying you of a wait time or to come inside immediately. The County Health Department testing site is located 4115 E. Harry (former Wichita Mall). - 2. Where can my employees (or volunteers) receive a no-cost COVID-19 Vaccination or booster? The Sedgwick County Health Department provides free COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters at the former Wichita Public Library in downtown Wichita (223 N. Main). An additional 11 mobile or partner clinics will also be held in the area where you can receive the COVID-19 vaccine. - 3. My employees are struggling to come back to work (or stay at work) because of the cost of child care. Is there any financial assistance available for my workers?

The Kansas Hero Relief Program may be able to help. An employee must be working at least 20 hours a week, using a state-licensed child care provider and meet income limits to receive financial assistance from this program. Visit the website to learn more & apply: www.ksherorelief.com.

4. I can't find enough workers to serve customers or clients. Where can I find help with recruiting and hiring new, qualified workers?

5. Are there any operating grants available for businesses or non-profits to help me safely re-open or stay open in 2021 and 2022?
