

#### What are the options?

The Sedgwick County Health Department (SCHD) can plan a clinic with you or partner you with another Vaccine Provider.

### SCHD Mobile Clinic

Clinic for your employees only or open to the public on a walk-in basis.

#### SCHD Direct Deployment

Employer identifies a specific number of doses needed, and SCHD administers those doses to the identified employees.

### SCHD Community Vaccine Clinic at 223 S. Main, Wichita

Employees go to the clinic to receive vaccine during operating hours.
