- I. Introductions and Announcements: None.
- II. **ACTION ITEM: Approval of Team Justice Minutes from the 9/10/21 Meeting. October 1, 2021 meeting was cancelled. Mark Masterson (via Zoom) motioned, Taunya Rutenbeck (via Zoom) seconded. - III. Juvenile Field Services/Evening Reporting Center Presentation – Larry Burks & Kevin Cocking provided a presentation on Juvenile Field Services and the Evening Reporting Center and were available for questions from the board.
- IV. Continuing Legal Education Training – Chase Tipton presented on the Continuing Legal Education (CLE) Training to take place on November 12, 2021 and was available for questions from the board. Team Justice Members were invited to attend the CLE.
- V. Team Justice Teen Member Update – Glenda Martens provided updates to the board regarding the Team Justice Teen Member position. A total of 8 applications were received. Two were disqualified due to not meeting the age requirements and 6 were offered interviews. Glenda states that she will present her recommendations before the Board of County Commissioners by December.
- VI. Data Updates: Steve Stonehouse provided data updates and was available for questions from the board. Steve also provided a letter from the Kansas Department of Corrections stating that Sedgwick County was compliant with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act.
- VII. Other Business: Glenda Martens informed the board that Russ Jennings, an advocate for juvenile justice reform, recently passed away.

Glenda also informed the board that she had recently held a legislative platform at Juvenile Field Services as a way to raise awareness about flat funding. Glenda has also testified before the Oversight Committee and presented before the Board of County Commissioners at a staff meeting as a way to work towards securing additional funding.
