

Healthcare Workers Isolation and Quarantine Guidance

Healthcare Workers with lab confirmed COVID-19 Infections	<p>Conventional Staffing Isolate for 10 days OR 7 days with negative test¹, if asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic (with improving symptoms)</p> <p>Contingency Staffing Isolate for 5 days with/without negative test if asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic (with improving symptoms)</p> <p>Crisis Staffing No work restriction with prioritization considerations for asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic healthcare workers</p>	Adopt CDC guidance with the additional requirement that, during Conventional or Contingency Staffing, work only with COVID-19 positive patients during the remainder of the 10-day infectious period.
BOOSTED Asymptomatic Healthcare Workers who are close contacts of a person with confirmed COVID-19 infection	<p>Conventional Staffing No work restrictions with negative test on days 2 and 5-7</p> <p>Contingency/Crisis Staffing No work restrictions</p>	Adopt CDC guidance as is.
VACCINATED or UNVACCINATED, EVEN IF WITHIN 90 DAYS OF PRIOR INFECTION Asymptomatic Healthcare Workers who are close contacts of a person with confirmed COVID-19 Infection.	<p>Conventional Staffing Quarantine for 10 days OR 7 days with negative test</p> <p>Contingency Staffing No work restrictions with negative tests on days 1, 2, 3 & 5-7</p> <p>Crisis Staffing No work restriction (test if possible)</p>	Adopt CDC guidance as is.
