AR – Armed Robbery at a Business  
BURGX- Burglary in progress of Unoccupied Structure  
CARJAC – Taking of a person’s car with force  
CODE25 – Barricaded Subject  
CUT – Assault with a knife or sharp object  
FIT – Firefighter in Trouble  
PIT – Paramedic in Trouble  
PKG – 3SI tracking alarm  
SHOOT – Shooting

ACTIVE – Active Shooter  
BURGIP – Burglary in progress at Occupied Structure  
BNKROB – Bank Robbery already occurred  
CLUB – Assault with a blunt object w/injuries  
DEVICE – Found Explosive Device  
OIT – Officer in Trouble  
HU – Duress or panic alarm at a business  
ROBIP – Robbery occurring at time of call  
SUB2/3 – Submersion in a large body of water

A2CA/A3CA – Airplane emergency @ Eisenhower Airport (Commercial Aircraft)  
02JO – Rape that just occurred (less than 10 min)  
48 – Injury Accident  
48HR - Injury Accident hit and run  
99JO – Escape Custody just occurred  
ANBITE – Animal Bite  
ASSIST – Assisting Law Enforcement Agency  
ATIP – Auto Theft happening at time of call  
BURGJO – Burglary of structure that has occurred  
CODE26 – Bomb threat  
COLA2/3 – Moderate/Major building collapse  
DRIVBY – Drive-by with shots fired  
ELECT – Person electrocuted  
FORGIP – Forgery occurring at the time of call  
HWYROB – Taking persons property in a public space with the use of or threat of force  
INDACC – Industrial accident  
METHSM – Report of a methamphetamine smell  
PA – Personal Alarm from a personal device (app)

A3GAA - Airplane emergency @ Eisenhower Airport (Small Aircraft)  
47HZ – Non injury accident w/ hazardous materials  
48T – Injury Accident w/people pinned  
48HZ - Injury Accident w/ hazardous materials  
ABDUCT – Abduction  
ASLT – Physical Assault w/ injuries  
ASSTE/F – Assisting Fire or EMS  
ATJO – Auto Theft that has occurred (less than 10 min)  
BURNS – Person with burn injuries  
COLA1 – Minor building collapse  
DISTWP – Disturbance with a weapon  
DVWP – Domestic violence with a weapon  
EXPLOS – Explosion  
HURES – Panic or duress alarm at a residence  
HZ2/3 – Hazardous materials spill moderate/major  
LARCIP – Larceny occurring at the time of call  
OXY – Fire or explosion at Oxy Chemicals  
PLANE – Plane crash; not at Eisenhower Airport

PSYCH – Person with psychiatric problems  
PURSE – Larceny of purse w/ no force (less than 10 min)  
SAR – Robbery of business w/ physical force  
SE – Silent Entry Alarm  
SUICID – Act or attempt of suicide  
VEH – Vehicle fire

### **Priority 1**

RESROB – Taking of property in a residence w/ force  
SCWP – Suspicious person with a weapon  
SIG4 – Suicidal person  
VANDIP – Vandalism occurring at the time of call  
WALKIN – Aggravated assault called in by a hospital  
WRONG – Wrong way driver

### **Priority 2**

O2RT – Rape report  
104HR – Hit and run accident with unknown injuries  
46 – Moving drunk driver  
ASDLTSL – Adult shoplifter that is apprehended  
ANIMAL – Any issue with a non-domesticated animal  
CKBUSN – Checking a business when something does not appear to be normal  
CKSHOT – When someone hears shots but does not know who is firing them  
DA – Courthouse disturbance alarms  
DUI – A drunk driver that is currently parked  
FORGJO – Forgery that occurred within the past 10 minutes  
FOUNDJ – Someone locates a child who is lost (excludes runaways)  
GDSALM – Gun shot detector alarm  
HZ6 – Unknown white powdery substance is located  
INDLIB – Consensual touching/fondling/sexual intercourse with a child less than 16 but over 14  
LARCJO – Larceny that has taken place within 10 minutes of call  
MANDWN – Used only in the city of Wichita for someone lying in a public place  
OD – Intentional ingestion of any substance causing an overdose

### **Priority 2**

104 – Accident with unknown injuries  
32PER – Checking for or picking up a wanted person  
ABUSE – Abuse report  
AGGRT – Assault with a weapon report  
BURGRT – Burglary report  
CKRES – Checking a residence when something does not appear to be normal  
CLOUD – Checking a dangerous looking storm cloud  
DIST – Disturbance in progress (verbal or physical)  
DV – Domestic violence disturbance  
FOUNDA – Adult reported as missing has been found or returned home  
GENALM – Audible burglary alarm of a residence or business  
HANGUP - Landline hang-up with no indication of an emergency  
INDEXP – Disrobing or exposing of genitals in public  
JUVSL – Juvenile shoplifter that is apprehended  
LOSTA – Adult over the age of 18, with mental or physical disability, that cannot be responsible for themselves is missing  
LOSTJ – Missing child typically in their pre-teen years (excludes runaways)  
PRVDIS – Citizen wants officers to prevent problems they feel may occur

## Priority 2

SC – Suspicious character

TILL – Money was removed from a register with no force used or implied

UNKP – Unknown call for police

VICDOG – Report of a vicious dog

WELFAR – Checking the welfare of a citizen

## Priority 2

SIGN – Traffic sign missing, down or damaged

UNKE – Unknown call for EMS

VANDJO – Vandalism that occurred within 10 minutes

WEAPON – Weapons violation

XPORT – Transporting a prisoner that is in custody

## Priority 3

32VEH – Found stolen vehicle

47HR – Non injury hit and run accident

48RT – Injury accident report

ABNVEH – Abandoned vehicle that is not stolen

ASSTC – Someone needs help but there is no emergency

BCST – Information broadcast

CARALM – Car alarm going off

CKLITE – Check a traffic light that is not on or malfunctioning

DISCRT – Disturbing of the peace complaint

FCC – Firework complaint with a complainant

FLOOD – Flooded roadway

LAB – Lab call out

LOCKED – Person locked either in or out of a vehicle

MISCP – Miscellaneous service for citizens that does not involve a report needing to be made

MSGP – Phone message for an officer

PFA – Protection from abuse needing to be served

ROBRT – Report of a robbery that occurred more than 30 minutes from time of call

TRSHRT – Trash dumping report

## Priority 3

47 – Non injury accident

47RT – Non injury accident report

99RT – Escaped prisoner report

ANICON – Any call that will be handled by animal control

ATC – Attempt to contact request from another agency

BOLO – Be on the lookout broadcast

CLRLOT – Clear a parking lot

CKRA – Checking for a runaway

DVRT – Domestic violence report

FCCNO – Firework complaint with no complainant

FORGRT – Forgery that occurred more than 10 minutes ago

FOUNDP – Found property

LARCGN – Larceny of a gun

MISCRT – Report that does not involve a crime of any type

PARTY – Loud party

PRKVIO – Parking violation

TRAFIC – Traffic hazard

VRDL – Any report of reckless driving, drag racing or speeding

ATRT – Auto Theft Report (10+ minutes)

ASLTRT – Simple Assault Report (10+ minutes)

DISTRRT – Disturbance Report (10+ minutes)

GRO – Theft of gas without payment

EMBEZ – Embezzlement Report

FRAUD – Con or swindling of money under false pretense

LARCRT – Larceny report (10+ minutes)

LOSTP – Lost or misplaced property report

RART – Runaway report

SCRT – Suspicious character gone report (10+ minutes)

VANDRT – Vandalism report (10+ minutes)
