On January 25, 2022, the PREA Committee conducted a review.

The review consisted of 0 substantiated cases.

The review consisted of 2 unfounded cases. Those cases were: 21S006055, 21S006696

This review consisted of 9 unsubstantiated cases. The unsubstantiated cases were: 21S003800, 21S003804, 21S003818, 21S004703, 21S007102, 21S007248, 21S007430, 21S007437, 21S010196


In reviewing each of the cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication, in either circumstance, a sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee potentially found no indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse, the staffing level was adequate, but there might be need for extra cameras. On case 21S010196 the victim claimed that the incident happened at court. Without further details we could not determine if it happened in the detention facility court holding cells or the court house holding cells. If there are no cameras in the courthouse, there potentially could be some for documentation. If there are cameras, access to that could help in any investigation that's made over there.
